PROPRIETARY NAME AND DOSAGE FORM

Neuroment-B tablets

COMPOSITION

Each tablet contains:

Pyridoxine (Vitamin B6) 100 mg

Thiamine (Vitamin B1) 50 mg

Cyanocobalamin (Vitamin B12) 100 µg

Sugar and lactose free.

Other excipients: microcrystalline cellulose, magnesium stearate, dicalcium phosphate dihydrate

PHARMACOLOGICAL CLASSIFICATION

INDICATIONS

Neuroment-B tablets are indicated where a deficiency of the relevant vitamins exists.

CONTRAINDICATIONS

Neuroment-B tablets should not be used in patients on levodopa therapy.

Hypersensitivity to any of the above ingredients.

WARNINGS AND SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS

Cyanocobalamin (vitamin B12) should not be given before a diagnosis has been fully established because of the possibility of masking symptoms of subacute degeneration of the spinal cord.

Cyanocobalamin is not a suitable source of vitamin B12 for the treatment of optic neuropathies associated with raised plasma concentrations of cyanocobalamin (the precautions are specifically for vitamin B12 and not the formulation as a whole).

PREGNANCY AND LACTATION

The safety of Neuroment-B in pregnancy and lactation has not been established.

DOSAGE AND DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Neuroment-B tablets may be administered in a dosage of 1 tablet daily or as prescribed by your doctor or pharmacist.

KNOWN SYMPTOMS OF OVERDOSAGE AND PARTICULARS OF ITS TREATMENT

Treatment is symptomatic and supportive.

IDENTIFICATION

White, round, film-coated tablets.

PRESENTATION

Neuroment-B is presented in bottles of 60 tablets.

STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS

Keep bottle tightly closed and store in a cool place (at or below 25°C).
